### MOST ACTIVE NEW MEMBER

This trophy was donated by Motohansa. Commencing in 2001 it is awarded to a new member who is a regular participant in club activities. Similar to the Clubman Awards it is calculated as follows.

In calculating the points for the most active new member, all members who joined in the previous calendar year (Jan 01 to Dec 31) are considered. For members joining before July 01, points are totalled from July 01 to June 30 (the club year or part thereof). If the member joined after July 01 then points are annualised (divided by the number of days that they had been a member and multiplied by 365).
